PO 401 Maintenance < Critical>	Learn and demonstrate limited skill with respect to: woodwind such as removing grease from the pads, reseating pads, adapting the ligature, replacing a pad; brass such as replace a water key cork, oiling and greasing the valves, and pistons, removing a stuck mouthpiece, replacing a string on a rotary valve; percussion such as replacing a head on a snare drum, bass drum, replacing cymbal handles, replacing a snare.

PO 403 Intonation < Critical>	Recognizes that pitch is sharp or flat in an ensemble. Adjusts instruments Accordingly.
PO 404 Prepared Music <Critical>	<p>Prepared Music - Select one song from each list:</p> <p>List A: Gardner Modern Method PT1; P47 Ext 12 or P48 Ext 13</p> <p>List B: New Gulf Drummer or Two Unaccompanied or Solos for Snare</p> <p>List C: Cool from West Side Story or Allegro-Locillet</p>
PO 405 Ensemble <Critical>	<p>Suggested Repertoire for Ensemble:</p> <p>Concert - Air for Band (Erickson), El Mirador (Chatman), Legend (Del Borgo), Three Ayres from Gloucester (Sturt); or</p> <p>Parade - General Salute, Advance; or March - Heart of Oak, PPCLI, RCAF, Military Escort, Eagle Squadron</p>
PO 406 Sight Reading <Critical>	<p>Will perform without help a musical selection no greater than 16 bars in length. The selection will be of a technical difficulty equivalent to one level below the musician level being tested. Given a brief period to look at the music and determine musical requirements of selection.</p> <p>Play music at appropriate skill level for the piece selected demonstrating:</p> <p>a) attention to notation and other directions for performance, b) an acceptable grasp of the style of the given music; and c) an ability to recognize and correct any errors made in the initial reading.</p>
PO 407 Ear Tests <Critical>	<p>Sing, clap or tap the rhythm (only) of a short melody after it has been played twice by the instructor.</p> <p>Time Signatures: 2/4, 3/4 and 6/8</p>
PO 408 Music Theory < Critical>	Demonstrate an understanding of Music Theory to include: The C Clefs, Chords, cadences, Transposition, Short Score and Open Score, Intervals, and The Dominant Seventh Chord to the standard of 60%. Reference is Lawless, Grade II Theory (Waterloo, 1991), pp 1-73. Alternate reference is Ecole de Musique Vincent D'Indy, Theorie de la Musique.
PO 409 Band Drill <Critical>	Highly skilled at band drill. Able to teach others in all aspect of band drill, instrument drill and to plan drill routines.
PO 410 Conducting <Critical>	Demonstrate a skill at conducting an ensemble utilizing the following time signatures: 2/4, 3/4, 4/4 and 6/8 with pick up, fermata, release, and preparatory beat.




